1. Position – Young Professional (2 Posts)

2. Qualification/Experience

- 1) A Master's degree is required; a Post graduate degree in any one subject including MBBS or equivalent, Public Health, Hospital Administration, Hospital Management, Health Management, Community Medicine, Medicine, Preventive and Social Medicine, Economics, Statistics, Demography, MD (Ayurveda/Homeopathy), Public Health Nutrition, Epidemiology, Health IT.
- 2) Minimum 2 years of demonstrative work experience in research projects.
- 3) Experience in public health, nutrition, social behaviour change communication and digital health technology is preferred.
- 4) Strong understanding of public health and nutrition issues and systems particularly maternal and child health

Desired Skills

- 1) Strong understanding of the health and nutrition sector.
- 2) Advanced proficiency in Microsoft Office applications including report writing and presentation. Ability to visualize how data and concepts can be communicated in different formats.
- 3) Proficiency to undertake advanced statistical data analysis
- 4) Ability to draft case studies, and policy briefs and capable to fact check and copy edit publications.
- 5) Adaptive communication skills, and interact professionally with all levels of stakeholders.
- 6) Proactive, attention to detail, prompt in resolving problems with the ability to work in a team.

3. Responsibilities

- 1) Assists in short-term and long-term research and implementation projects. This may include literature reviews, data collection, compilation and analysis, documenting case studies, etc.
- 2) Monitoring of primary data collection and field visits for data quality checks on a time-to-time basis.
- 3) Support in the development of data validation tools including a checklist and semi-structured questionnaire for research projects.
- 4) Draft reports, policy brief, and statistical analysis, editing, and/or proofreading of articles and presentations.

- 5) Support in organizing the research symposium and stakeholder consultation and documentation.
- 6) Coordinate, monitoring and reporting of the implementation of the proposed interventions.

7. About Task Force

State Health Resource Centre is one of the verticals at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Good Governance and Policy Analysis and supports strengthening Madhya Pradesh's public health system. The primary objective of the SHRC is to assist in strengthening the health systems of Madhya Pradesh, with a focus on areas including policy planning, strategy development, providing technical assistance to the state, and identifying areas where service delivery could be improved to improve health outcomes. The Centre also serves as a technical secretariat of the Task Force on the reduction of Neonatal, Infant, Maternal Mortality and Malnutrition in Madhya Pradesh constituted by the Government of Madhya Pradesh.

This task force was constituted to bring down Neonatal, Infant, Maternal Mortality Rate and Malnutrition (stunting) in the state of Madhya Pradesh. Prof Shamika Ravi, Non-Resident Senior Fellow Brookings Institute and Former Member EAC to PM is the Chairperson of the Task Force, Dr. Ramesh Agarwal Chief of Neonatology, AIIMS Delhi and Dr. Suparna Ghosh-Jerath, Professor & Head, Community Nutrition IIPH-Delhi are the subject experts of the Task Force. The Task Force has submitted its final report with key interventions to be implemented in the coming years. To support the Task Force in research, monitoring and writing case studies and documentation, a research team is to be set up within SHRC. Besides intervention research support, Task Force planned to undertake systematic scientific documentation of undergoing interventions that would benefit other states including Madhya Pradesh. The scope of the Task Force is:

1. To act as a steering committee to support in the strengthening of neonatal, Infant, and maternal health care and nutrition services in Madhya Pradesh.
2. To provide technical support in review meetings conducted by Honorable Chief Minister/Chief Secretary/Additional Chief Secretary to track the progress of the neonatal, infant, maternal and nutrition-related interventions.
3. To facilitate partnerships with bilateral/multilateral organizations, technical agencies and health sector experts.
4. To facilitate discussions and workshops on the aforementioned subjects of interventions and other public health areas.
